Scholarship places will be awarded based on an outstanding performance in the examinations. Short listed candidates will be invited for a panel interview and will be required to demonstrate in a practical assessment, a level of excellence and natural aptitude in their chosen Scholarship category. Concerned parents are encouraged to assist us as we prepare the children during this Christmas vacation break.

Lagos - Civic Centre (Grand Banquet Hall) Ozumba Mbadiwe Avenue, Victoria Island.

Abuja - The Transcorp Hilton (Nassarawa Hall)

Port-Harcourt - Montessori International School, No. 58, King Perekule Street, GRA Phase 2, Port-Harcourt
