2009 EXTERNAL EXAMINATION RESULTS

REGISTRATION FOR EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

In keeping with our culture of promoting academic excellence, our Grade 11 students have the opportunity to sit for the Cambridge 'O' Level examinations as a trial run for official use only. The analysis of their performance in the exam provides useful information for teachers to improve their preparation towards their terminating examination in Grade 12..

We reiterate that registration of Grade 9 and Grade 11 students for the May/June 2010 Cambridge Checkpoint and the Cambridge O' Level examinations respectively is subject to their performance at the end of this term (Genesis).

Students must obtain the approved cut-off score in Maths, English and Integrated Science to write the Cambridge Checkpoint exam (Grade 9) while students in Grade 11 must obtain the approved cut-off score in at least eight subjects including Mathematics and English.
