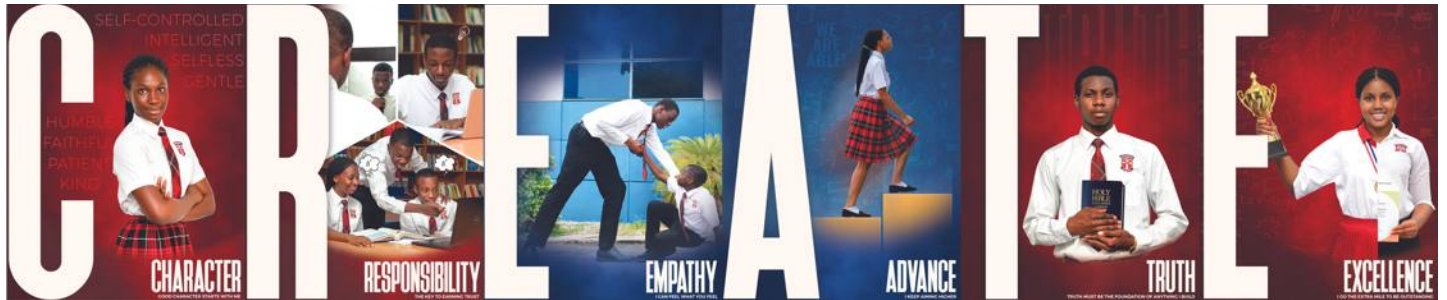
FROM: THE PRINCIPAL

SELECTION OF SUBJECTS FOR GRADES 9 AND 10

1. Incoming Grade 9

Parents of incoming Grade 9 students are encouraged to discuss subject choices with their children bearing in mind their interests, capability and potential. Forms will be sent by email for this purpose and should be completed before resumption.

2. Incoming Grade 10

Subject selection for Grade 10 will be done on resumption in accordance with the student's performance in their Cambridge Checkpoint/IJSCE. The curriculum/subject selection forms will be sent in due course.



OCTOBER/NOVEMBER 2022 CAMBRIDGE EXAMINATION REGISTRATION

This is to inform parents of grade 11 students (progressing to grade 12) that registration for the Oct/Nov examination has commenced. Draft registration forms were given to students before close of school to facilitate discussion with their parents. These have been returned for processing and emails will be sent to all parents shortly communicating the registration details and exam fees payable.

Please note that this exam is a trial run for official use only. The deadline for payment of exam fee is 8th August 2022. Statement of results/certificates will be available for collection at graduation.
