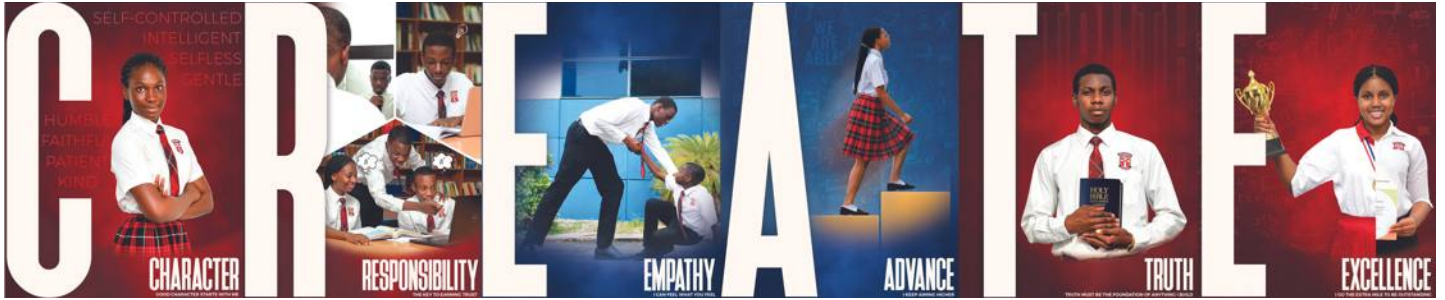

## INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION (IJSCE)

The IJSCE examinations for students in grade nine (9) will commence on 6th June 2022 and end on the 17th instant. It is an examination based on the broad-based Key Stage 3 syllabus that assesses students in 14 core and 2 optional subjects. The best student overall with an A\* in at least 10 core subjects (Mathematics, English and Science inclusive) and 3 A's will be offered a 50% scholarship (on tuition) for the entire duration of their senior high school tenure. We would like to remind you that we operate a dual curricular system – the Nigerian or Regional curriculum and the Cambridge International curriculum. Parents may opt for either stream as from 10th Grade.

## CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Out of class learning is always fun and we experienced this on assembly this half term! A blend of student and teacher-led presentations were organized to create awareness, provide a platform to nurture speaking skills, inspire and guide our student community as to how to thrive in our world.

Our C-R-E-A-T-E presentation boldly shared our core values as a school among all students and teachers while the entrepreneurial talk on 'Creativity, Innovation and Enterprise' brought to light the concept of using business to create sustained positive impact in our communities. Learner attributes were next as we reminded ourselves about attitudes that improve or hinder active learning. 'Staying safe' highlighted the need to cultivate safe habits such as not giving out personal information online without first notifying an adult to determine if it is safe to do so..

Thank you for fully complying with our Covid-19 protocol. As our children depart to various destinations I am aware there is a strong sense that the pandemic is over and there should be no need for further Covid tests, face masking, chlorination, hand sanitizing, restricted contacts and other measures when we resume on the 4th of June.



The figures from China, North Korea and the USA show that transmission of the virus is still going on even though with less virulence.

We would like to appeal to our parents and returning students to consider students in grades 9, 12 and A-levels who have remained in the bubble and are writing (or will soon write) career-defining exams through the month of June.

An entry of Covid-19 infection into the system at this time will severely disrupt preparations and final examinations.

We therefore appeal, in the spirit of being our brothers' keeper and looking not only to the things that concern us; but bearing the burden of others that we go through the labour of Covid-19 Antigen testing (hopefully for the last time) as we return from the midterm break. Our confidence continues to be in Almighty God to have our back as we do all the good we know to do.

The Covid-19 Antigen Test is faster (less than an hour) and should be done no earlier than Thursday 2nd of June.

It can be done in any standard duly registered medical laboratory that has a laboratory scientist to sign off on the result. Self-administered lateral flow home kit test results will not be accepted. We look forward to a completely Covid-19 protocol-free 2022/23 session in Jesus' name amen
