MID-TERM BREAK AND RESUMPTION



NIGERIA'S 62nd INDEPENDENCE ANNIVERSARY

The 62nd Independence Day was celebrated with poems and essays, a panel discussion, a cultural show and sports fiesta. Patriotism topped the agenda as the theme of the day "The Nigeria of our Dreams" came alive through activities. The theme was reduced to four simple phrases:

- Proudly Nigerian (PN)- Meaning we will wear Nigeria on our sleeves and be great ambassadors of our country.
- Made in Nigeria (MIN)- to use our learning to make Nigeria a centre of excellence in creativity, ingenuity and as an international solution provider to make the world a better place.
- Psalm 33 (Ps 33 vs 12)- "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord; and the people whom he hath chosen for his own inheritance". Our belief in a better Nigeria.
- Arise and Shine (AS)- Change begins with us (the youth of Nigeria) to rise and shine in order to manifest the glory of the Lord.

CELEBRATING QUEEN ELIZABETH'S LIFE AND LEGACY

Lessons to be gleaned from the life and legacy of Queen Elizabeth II, the United Kingdom's longest-reigning monarch, were amply discussed as students and teachers shared their opinions about her values and virtues. The session, anchored by A-level students and members of Management left us humbled and inspired.
