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INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION (IJSCE)

The IJSCE examinations for students in grade nine (9) will commence on 5th June 2023 and end on the 16th instant. It is an examination based on the broad-based Key Stage 3 syllabus that assesses students in 14 core and 2 optional subjects. The best student overall with an A* in at least 10 core subjects (Mathematics, English and Science inclusive) and 3 A's will be offered a 50% scholarship (on tuition) for the entire duration of their senior high school tenure. We would like to remind you that we operate a dual curricular system – the Nigerian or Regional curriculum and the Cambridge International curriculum. Parents may opt for either stream as from 10th Grade.

SCHOOL TOUR TO SINGAPORE

Hurray, our exciting tradition of annual trips to amazing destinations of the world is back! Our tour this year takes us to the island nation of Singapore in the first two weeks of December. Over the years, the school has visited several countries: Japan, Malaysia, Thailand, China, Singapore, Barbados & St Kitts, Brazil, Dubai, South Africa, Egypt, Tanzania, Kenya, amongst others.

In 2012, an 80-man contingent of students and officials visited Singapore; another group had the privilege in 2017 and their experiences were simply unforgettable.

HARVEST MID-TERM ASSIGNMENTS

Our mid-term assignments are designed to prepare students for the Promotion Exams.

- Grade 7 and 8 students are to reflect on topics covered in all subjects this half term and prepare a scrapbook to summarize their reflections. You are to dedicate at least a page to each subject using bullet points, mind maps, charts, pictures and short notes. Scrapbooks are expected to be neatly bound and handed in on Monday 5th June, 2023.
- Grade 10 and 11 students will be using the interactive learning platform Seneca. Students have been
 provided with login details and are expected to spend a minimum of two hours daily revising topics
 covered in their respective subjects since the session began.
