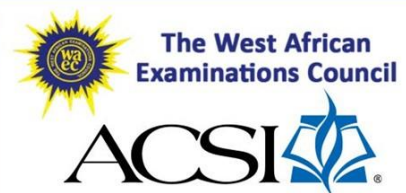
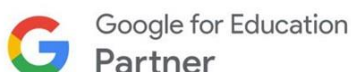
- Cambridge and WAEC exams: End second week of June 2025

INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION (IJSCE)

The IJSCE examinations for students in grade nine (9) begins on Wednesday 4th June 2025 and will end on the 18th instant. This examination is based on the broad-based Key Stage 3 syllabus that assesses students in 16 core and one or two optional subjects.

The best student overall with an A* in at least 10 core subjects (Mathematics, English and Science inclusive) and 4 A's will be offered a 50% scholarship (on tuition) for the entire duration of their senior high school tenure. We would like to remind you that we operate a dual curricular system – the Regional (WAEC) curriculum and the International (Cambridge) curriculum. Parents may opt for either stream as from 10th Grade.

CEO'S DINNER AND PROM NIGHT

As our graduating students approach their final week at Lifeforte, we are delighted to share details of two special events that will bring this chapter to a close.

The CEO's Dinner will provide an opportunity for our students to reflect on their journey with us, sharing stories and insights from their time at Lifeforte. This will be a meaningful occasion for them to connect with our leadership team and celebrate their achievements.

Prom Night will be a memorable occasion for our graduands to mark this significant milestone with their juniors in grades 10 and 11.

HARVEST MID-TERM ASSIGNMENTS

The mid-term assignments are designed to prepare students for the Promotion Exams.

Grade 7 and 8 students are to reflect on topics covered in all subjects this half term and prepare a scrapbook to summarize their reflections. You are to dedicate at least a page to each subject using bullet points, mind maps, charts, pictures and short notes. Scrapbooks are expected to be neatly bound and handed in on Monday 9th June, 2025.

Grade 10 and 11 students will be using the interactive learning platform Seneca and their google classroom and are expected to spend a minimum of two hours daily revising topics covered in their respective subjects since the session began. The link to Seneca has been posted to the general class in their google classroom.

NOTEBOOKS

Parents/guardians should please ensure that their children/wards return to school with ALL notebooks from previous years in addition to the current session's notes except for grade 10. This is essential for excellent success in the Harvest (promotion) examination.


PASTORAL MATTERS
